As another harvest has concluded and as you begin to look at inputs for next season's crop, I would encourage you to consider CFA for your input financing needs.

Ag Partners Coop in conjunction with **The Cooperative Finance Association (CFA)** gives you the ability to incorporate a flexible, full crop input loan program along with your current operating line of credit. The CFA Input Finance program features an attractive interest rate that allows you to fund all of your inputs where you make your purchases. With a maturity date as late as March 15th, 2020, the ability to market your grain after harvest is an added benefit to this program.
